NFHS rules call for a 30-minute suspension of play when lightning is seen or thunder is heard. Any subsequent lightning strikes or thunder after the beginning of the 30-minute count should reset the clock and another count should begin.

Sliding	For all NBSA games, High School Rules will apply. Refer to NFHS rules Sections 2-32 & 8-4-2b which is published at the end of these rules. NOTE: A runner is NOT required to slide. If the runner does slide, it must be a legal slide (see rule below). If the runner doesn't slide, he must avoid interfering with the play. Ejection of the runner is the umpire's discretion if malicious intent is determined.

The stealing home rule does not protect that runner from being put out. 3) A failed suicide squeeze is considered a steal attempt.

Pitching Machine Bat Restrictions:	USSSA Rules Apply. The maximum diameter shall not exceed 2-3/4 inches and the maximum length shall not exceed 36 inches. Bats should not exceed the 1.15 BPF (Bat Performance Factor) as defined for baseball bats by ASTM Standards. Big barrel bats (diameters of 2-5/8" or 2-3/4") must have the USSSA 1.15 BPF mark. Older big barrel bats will not be allowed. Small barrel bats (diamet of 2-1/2") must have the USSSA 1.15 BPF mark as well. Also, BBCOR-certified and solid (one-piece) wood bats are legal.

3rd Strike Rule Applies?	No. On a dropped 3rd strike, the batter is out and the ball is live. Per League Rules								
Infield Fly Rule	Yes								
Thrown Bat Policy	Per batter - 1st thrown bat, warning. 2nd thrown bat, player is declared "out" after play ends. 3rd thrown bat, player is ejected after play ends. Exception: In any case that a thrown bat results in an injury (catcher, on deck batter, umpire), play is immediately ruled dead and warning, out, or ejection is enforced with all runners returning to original bases. Note: "Thrown" and "injury" are determined by the umpire and not subject to debate.								
	Once a team has three players with warnings, a "team" warning is issued. All players are considered to have warnings. Players who have already been called out are still subject to ejection after their next offense.

Absent Without Injury or Illness	For all NBSA games, if a player becomes absent during the game for a reason other than injury or illness the player will be skipped in the lineup without penalty. A player who leaves the game early is not required to play 2 innings in the infield.								
Ejected Players, Coaches and Managers	Any player, coach or manager ejected, for any reason, will receive a mandatory 1 game suspension to be served during the next NBSA game. Additional suspensions and/or disciplinary actions may be enforced pending the NBSA board review. During the suspension the player, coach or manage may not enter the confines of the park or recreational area that supports the field of play. Failure to report a suspended player, coach or manager will be grounds for additional suspensions
